General Fund

Taonga School

The school continues to grow, and is now also supported by 'Africa Arise' who sponsor some of the children and also provide breakfast daily for all the school.

Food for Work

We have added this project due to the falling value of the local currency, which is causing hardship for many families. The aim is to find something for the unemployed to do, in order to give them a sense of earning rather than feeling they have been given handouts.
